- 1. Three letters of recommendation.**
- 2. Entering freshman and students who have completed less than 30 hours of college credit need to provide a copy of their high school transcript and a copy of ACT or SAT scores.**
- 3. Students who have completed at least 12 hours of college credit need to provide an official transcript from each college attended which includes grades from the most recent semester completed.**
- 4. One billfold size picture.**

- * Students must be enrolled on a full-time basis to be eligible to apply - 12 credit hours as an undergraduate, 6 credit hours as a graduate.**
 - * Students must have a minimum 2.50 grade point average to be eligible to apply.**
 - * Scholarships are available for attendance at accredited state supported universities, private universities, junior colleges, or vocational schools.**
 - * Seven scholarships will be awarded for \$1500 each. These will be presented at the NPEC annual meeting on April 19, 2010. Attendance is expected if possible.**
 - * North Plains will give one scholarship to a person residing in each of the seven school districts within the NPEC service area. If no qualified applicants in a district exist, the Opportunity Plan will select the additional recipient(s).**
 - * Scholarship money will be advanced directly to the recipient contingent upon meeting the enrollment status of full-time.**
