- Must live within NPEC's service territory (Hutchinson, Hansford, Ochiltree, Lipscomb, Hemphill, or Roberts counties). You do <u>not</u> have to be a co-op member to apply.
- 3. Must have parent or guardian permission to participate.
- 4. Must be in good academic standing in all classes.
- 5. Completed *application and video* must be submitted by December 30, 2025.
